CELL PHONE vs BIBLE

I wonder what would happen if we treated our Bible like we treat our cell phone?

What if we carried it around in our purses or pockets?

What if we flipped through it several times a day?

What if we turned back to go get it if we forgot it?

What if we used it to receive messages from the text?

What if we treated it like we couldn't live without it?

What if we gave it to Kids as gifts?

What if we used it when we traveled?

What if we used it in case of emergency?

This is something to make you go...hmm...where is my Bible?

Oh, and one more thing. Unlike our cell phone, we don't have to worry about our Bible being disconnected because Jesus already paid the bill. Makes you stop and thing "where are my priorities?" And no dropped calls!

Electronic Giving

We have **two ways** to give electronically to the church.

- 1. At the Davis Memorial Website www.davismemorialchristian.org. Go to home page and in upper left hand corner is the "GIVE" button. (Green in Color) Click on the button and it takes you to a giving page where you will enter your personal information to initiate a donation.
- 2. Download the Tithe.ly Application from the internet either at Google Play App Store if you have an Android Phone or the Apple App Store for Apple Phones.
 - a. Once you have the Tithe.ly Giving Application downloaded on your phone you can then open the application.
 - Next you will search for Davis Memorial Christian Church Taylorville, IL and set this as your primary church.

These next steps apply to both of the above options:

You will then be asked to identify the donation being either made from a bank account or a card.

- a. If you choose a bank you will need to be able to provide the routing number of the bank and your account number. These can be obtained from the bottom of a personal check.
- b. If you choose a card then you would provide your card information.
- c. This will then set whatever information you provide as your primary giving source. You can identify more than one method and it will be stored for future use.
- d. You can also set up at this time the ability to have this be a reoccurring donation and you can identify how often you want it made from your payment source.

You will then be asked if you want to pay the fee which would be added to your base donation or have it deducted from your donation and the church would receive your donation net of the fee. The fee is less expensive if a bank account is used compared to a card. As an example the fee for a \$25.00 donation would be \$.55 with a bank account and \$.93 with a card.

At this time a donation shows it will go to the **General Account** of the church. In the future we may set up more options where the funds can be specifically donated.

The company we are using, Tithe.ly has been offering this service for electronic giving for over five years. They have over 20,000 churches currently using their platform.
